

**APPENDIX
TO THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF CHILE
AND
CARLETON UNIVERSITY**

PROGRAM: **“ACADEMIC COOPERATION PROGRAM BETWEEN
THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AT CARLETON
UNIVERSITY AND THE FACULTY OF ECONOMIC AND
ADMINISTRATIVE SCIENCES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
CHILE”**

Article 1: Objectives of the Appendix

The objective of this Appendix is to develop a program for academic cooperation between the parties, involving joint research and faculty and student exchange, under the general terms of the Cooperative Agreement subscribed between the two Universities.

Article 2: Implementation

The parties agree on the following terms to implement the program:

- 2.1 The number of faculty members and students participating in the exchange program, may vary each year, but it is expected that at least one faculty member and up to five students from each institution will be involved in research and educational programs annually.
- 2.2 Students will register and pay normal tuition fees at their home university. The host university, thus, will not charge tuition to exchange students, unless anyone of them chooses to register in a formal degree program.
- 2.3 Incoming exchange students at Carleton University are required to enroll in a mandatory university health plan at their own expense.
- 2.4 Accommodation, travel, and living expenses will be assumed by individual participants.

2.5 The two parties will provide information on suitable accommodation for faculty and students coming under the exchange program.

Article 3: Coordinators

The Program will be coordinated and administered by the Office of the Director of Carleton International at Carleton University, and the Dirección de Relaciones Internacionales of the Faculty of Economic and Administrative Sciences at the University of Chile.

Article 4: Validity


It is expected that this program begins in September 1998 for an initial period of five years.
