## GENERAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CHILE

In order to foster academic exchange and learning between The University of British Columbia and The University of Chile, the two institutions have agreed upon the following program based upon principles of mutual equality and reciprocity of benefits.

- 1. The two institutions will make suitable arrangements for the exchange of visiting scholars and students for study and research. Opportunities for cultural and sports exchanges will also be explored.
- 2. The two institutions will seek opportunities to cooperate in scientific research. The details of specific research projects will be determined by mutual agreement of both institutions. The form of cooperation may vary with the goal of each project.
- 3. The two institutions will exchange academic information, research papers, indices to thesis, books and magazines on relevant subjects where possible and appropriate.
- 4. The two institutions will extend invitations for attending scholarly and technical meetings and assist in making arrangements for attending national and international conferences.
- 5. Arrangements concerning specific details of financial support of visiting scholars, exchange faculty members, exchange students, and others will be made by individual written agreement applicable to each particular situation.

6. This Agreement may be modified by mutual consent. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years. It shall be extended automatically for an additional period of five years at each expiration date unless either party gives six months' advance notice in writing to terminate the Agreement.
