

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of this 10 day of Agosto, 1965, by and between the UNIVERSITY OF CHILE, represented by its Rector and hereinafter referred to as "the University", and THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, a California corporation, hereinafter referred to as "The Regents",

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, it would be mutually beneficial to establish a program of cooperation between the parties in order to achieve significant contributions to the development of the educational programs of each of the parties,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

1. As a basis for a program of cooperation, each party shall recognize the courses of study and academic degrees of the other party and shall provide access for personnel of the other party to its general institutional facilities. The recognition of the courses of study and academic degrees of The Regents on the part of the University shall be put into effect according to the terms of a regulation which in due course will be proclaimed by the Honorable University Council of the University. Furthermore, the parties shall exchange information and publications of common interest in the furtherance of this program of coopera-

2. Each party shall establish a special committee whose purposes shall be to:

(a) Guide the overall cooperative relationship and program between the parties and coordinate the common general activities between the parties, and

(b) Formulate specific programs to implement the general purpose of this cooperative agreement as set forth in the WHEREAS clause set forth above.

Said special committees shall cooperate and coordinate with one another and use their best efforts to formulate mutually acceptable specific programs consistent with the general purpose of this agreement. Any mutually acceptable specific program so formulated, and the terms and conditions thereof, shall be set forth in detail as a written amendment to this agreement.

3. Upon the establishment of any specific program as hereinabove provided, each party, when appropriate, shall establish a subcommittee of its respective special committee to administer each party's respective responsibilities under such specific program.

4. When the parties formulate a mutually acceptable specific program hereunder for which there is a need to receive external funding, the parties agree to make a joint proposal therefor to appropriate Foundations, or to Agencies of the respective Governments of Chile and the United States, to obtain the necessary funds to carry out such specific programs.

5. There shall be at least one annual meeting of the representatives of the special committees of the

program of cooperation and to evaluate the results of each specific program hereunder established.

6. This agreement may be terminated by either party at any time during its duration on written notice given thirty (30) days in advance of termination.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this agreement as of the day and year first above written.
