

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of this 18th day of November, 1991, by and between the UNIVERSITY OF CHILE, represented by its Rector, Dr. Jaime Lavados M., and THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, LOS ANGELES, represented by Dr. Elwin V. Svenson,

WITNESSETH :

WHEREAS, the University of Chile and the University of California have developed fruitful cooperative programs in the past, under the terms of an Agreement signed on August 10, 1965, which stated as its main goal to achieve significant contributions to the development of the educational programs of each of the parties,

WHEREAS, said Agreement was modified on several occasions (1976, 1978, 1987) according to changing circumstances confronting the University of

Chile - University of California Cooperative Program,

WHEREAS, the University of Chile has initiated a new era of modernization under the direction of the newly elected Rector, which assures a continued commitment toward its international programs,

WHEREAS, the University of Chile and the University of California have concluded that the goals of the original Agreement are still desirable, and that new circumstances within the University of Chile make possible their accomplishment,


WHEREAS, the two parties have stated the need to specify the appropriate new terms under which they are willing to undertake collaborative endeavours,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

- 1.- The parties shall identify the areas of common interest and shall elaborate the projects to be developed jointly.
- 2.- Each project shall be approved as an Addendum to this Agreement. In the Addendum there shall be a description of the project including its academic, scientific, administrative, and financial details.
- 3.- The development of the mutually agreed projects shall involve the exchange of selected faculty and students between the two universities.
- 4.- Any students or professional personnel that are accepted from the University of Chile for training in specified programs by the University of California will be subject to such regulations of the University of Chile and of the University of California as will insure their return to Chile after their

12.- This Agreement is signed in four copies (two in English and two in Spanish), one of each version to be kept by each party.
