

AGREEMENT FOR THE EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

BETWEEN

VICTORIA UNIVERSITY OF WELLINGTON

AND

UNIVERSITY OF CHILE

Victoria University of Wellington, New Zealand, as the New Zealand Sponsor, and University of Chile, hereby agree upon the following terms and conditions for a Students Exchange Agreement.

1. Within the frame of this exchange, home university will mean the institution in which the student is formally enrolled as a degree candidate, and host university will mean the institution that has agreed to receive students from the home university for a period of study on a non-degree basis.
2. Each home institution, respecting the admission requirements of the host institution, shall assume full responsibility for the assessment and selection of qualified candidates. The selection process shall consist of careful evaluation of the student's previous record, motivation, and overall potential to succeed in an international academic environment.
3. Participation in the exchange does not guarantee later admission as a regular student at the host institution nor does it establish residence. A student wishing to pursue a degree at the host institution must contact the admissions office and follow the regular application procedures.
4. In order to comply with government regulations, students from both institutions will be required to provide a guarantee that they have the financial resources to meet expenses not covered by the agreement. Both institutions will, however, assist to entry by making information available in other practical ways as requested.
5. To begin with, each institution shall accept up to two students each semester (maximum 4 students per year), at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
